

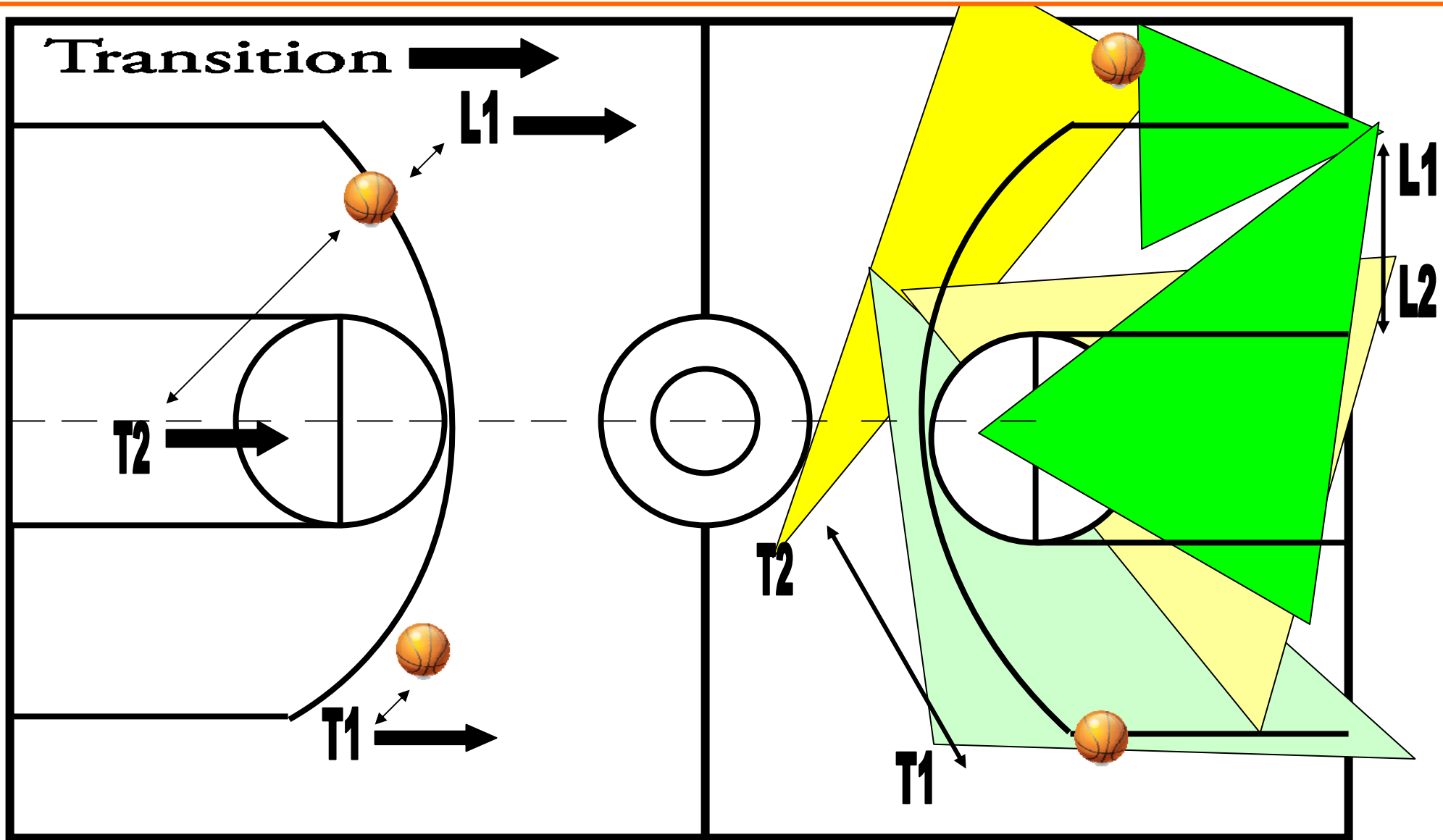
In 2-person mechanics, in the front court, officials should be in positions T1, T2, L1 or L2 or on their way to one of those positions.

If the ball is on your side of the front court, the trail shall be @ T1. If the ball is on other side of the front court the trail shall be in @ T2.

If the ball is on the top or your side of the court, the lead shall be @ L1. If the ball is on the other side of the court the lead shall be @ L2

In transition, the new lead shall move to L1 or L2 when the ball crosses mid-court depending on the position of the ball when it crosses mid-court.

In transition, the new trail shall follow the ball up the court anticipating the position of T1 or T2 depending on the location of the ball. The new trail shall not cross the imaginary center of the court split down the middle indicated by the broken line on the diagram.
